

**MINUTES
BROWN COUNTY/ABERDEEN CITY PLANNING COMMISSION
May 21, 2019**

The Joint Planning Commission meeting was called to order by Chairman Dean Marske. County Planning Commission members present at roll call were Beckler, Kurth, North, Streckfuss, Bettmann, Kippley, and Keatts. City Planning Commission members present at roll call were Schumacher, Mitchell, Lien, Woodward, Marske, and Mettler. Cogley was absent. Also present were Brett Bill, Planning & Zoning Director, Ron Wager, City Attorney, Ken Hubbart, City Planner, Eric Miller, City Planner, and Paula Nelson, Planning Commission Secretary.

Beckler moved and Keatts seconded to approve the amended minutes of April 16, 2019, all members voting aye, the motion carried.

OPEN FORUM - No one was present.

There being no old business Chairman Marske began with new business as follows:

- 1) Recommendation of Approval and Adoption, by the City Council, of an Ordinance Amending the Aberdeen City Code and Repealing Extraterritorial Zoning Jurisdiction. Brett Bill stated that at the direction of the City Council, the City Planning and Zoning Department staff and the City Attorney have prepared an ordinance amending the extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction. This ordinance will repeal the extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction and dissolve the joint jurisdictional area exercised with Brown County. Staff recommends approval of the Ordinances Amending the Aberdeen City Code and Repealing Extraterritorial Zoning Jurisdiction. Following discussion Schumacher moved and Mitchell seconded to approve. Rachel Kippley stated that she wanted to be on record as saying "it's important to note that this is something the county never asked for. We thought the public would be best served by a joint board. If this is the route the city wants to go, we can definitely work with that." Upon roll call: 1) All Brown County members voting aye (7-aye, 0-nay), the motion carried, and 2) All City members voting aye (6-aye, 0-nay), the motion carried.

There being no further business before the Commission, Schumacher moved and Kurth seconded to adjourn the meeting.
