City Council Chambers, 123 South Lincoln Street, Municipal Building, Aberdeen, South Dakota, June 11, 2020 at 5:00 p.m., regular meeting of the Board of City Council Members, Mayor Travis Schaunaman presiding. Present at roll call were City Council Members Mark Remily by teleconference, Rob Ronayne, Dave Lunzman by teleconference, Josh Rife by teleconference, Alan Johnson, David Bunsness, Dennis "Mike" Olson by teleconference, and Clint Rux. City Staff present were Lynn Lander by teleconference, Ron Wager by teleconference, Brett Bill by teleconference, Karl Alberts, and Dave McNeil by teleconference.

Mayor Schaunaman led the Pledge of Allegiance.

OLD BUSINESS**ORDINANCE NO. 20-06-02 - EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 4**

City Attorney Ron Wager presented Ordinance No. 20-06-02 (Emergency Ordinance No. 4) regarding the novel coronavirus COVID-19 public health crisis for possible second reading and final adoption. Wager stated that, if the ordinance is approved at second reading, it will become effective on June 13, 2020. Motion by Bunsness, second by Ronayne to approve second reading and final adoption of Ordinance No. 20-06-02 (COVID-19 Emergency Ordinance No. 4) pursuant to Aberdeen City Charter, Sec. 2.14. Discussion followed. Greg Jensen was present to discuss the proposed ordinance. Mayor Schaunaman called for a vote on the main motion to approve second reading and final adoption of Ordinance No. 20-06-02 (COVID-19 Emergency Ordinance No. 4). Upon roll call vote, Remily, Ronayne, Lunzman, Bunsness, and Olson voting aye, Rife, Johnson, Rux, and Mayor Schaunaman voting nay, 5 voting aye and 4 voting nay, motion failed for lack of at least 60% of the members present voting in favor of the emergency ordinance.

NEW BUSINESS**RESOLUTION NO. 20-06-06R**

City Attorney Ron Wager explained that, if the Council does not adopt Resolution No. 20-06-06R extending Emergency Ordinance No. 3 regarding the novel coronavirus COVID-19 public health crisis, the ordinance will be repealed on June 12, 2020 and automatically repealed on June 13, 2020. Motion by Rux, second by Bunsness to approve Resolution No. 20-06-06R extending Emergency Ordinance No. 3 regarding the novel coronavirus COVID-19 public health crisis. Upon roll call vote, Rux and Olson voting aye, Bunsness, Johnson, Rife, Lunzman, Ronayne, Remily, and Mayor Schaunaman voting nay, motion failed.

ADJOURN

There being no further business, motion by Bunsness, second by Rux to adjourn the meeting. Upon roll call vote, all voting aye, motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 5:38 p.m.
