

## Sand Castle Rules and Information

As part of the Family Fun Weekend, the Aberdeen Parks, Recreation and Forestry Department will be sponsoring a Sand Castle/Sand Sculpture Contest at Wylie Beach on Saturday June 9, 2018 from 4-5 p.m.

Family teams of all ages will have the opportunity to compete for prizes by building either a sand castle or sculpture. There is no limit to the number members per team. Teams should provide their own building materials and tools.

Prizes will be awarded to the best castle structure, the best sculpture structure and for showmanship during the building process.

Registration for family teams will begin at 3:30 p.m. with building limited to the hour of 4 to 5 p.m. Judging will be at 5 p.m. A list of rules for the competition is available at the ARCC or at the Parks, Recreation and Forestry Website.

### Rules:

1. Sand Castles and Sand Sculptures must consist of sand only with the exception of wood, rocks, shells, etc., found on the beach the day of the contest and used as decorations only. *Glass and animals are not permitted on the beach area.*
2. No superstructures or permanent forms of any kind shall be incorporated in your structure.
3. Sand forms (flower pots, milk cartons, buckets, etc.) may be used, but only as forms.
4. The use of shovels, hoes, spatulas and other tools (except power tools) are permitted.
5. The castle or sculpture must be confined within the assigned space.
6. Structures must be completed by the deadline time of 5 p.m. Building supplies for the sculpture must be removed prior to judging.
