DISC GOLF: OBJECT OF THE GAME

- To play each hole in the fewest throws (strokes) possible.
- The player with the lowest total strokes for the course wins.
- Safety first.
- Never throw when players or park users are within range.
- Always give park users right of way.
- Be aware of your surrounding and environment.

GUIDELINES FOR PLAY

- Each hole begins at the tee pad.
- Subsequent throws are made from the place where the disc comes to rest.
- The player who is furthest from the basket throws first.
- The hole is completed when the disc is in the basket.
- Tee off order is determined by players' scores on the previous hole. Lowest score tees first.

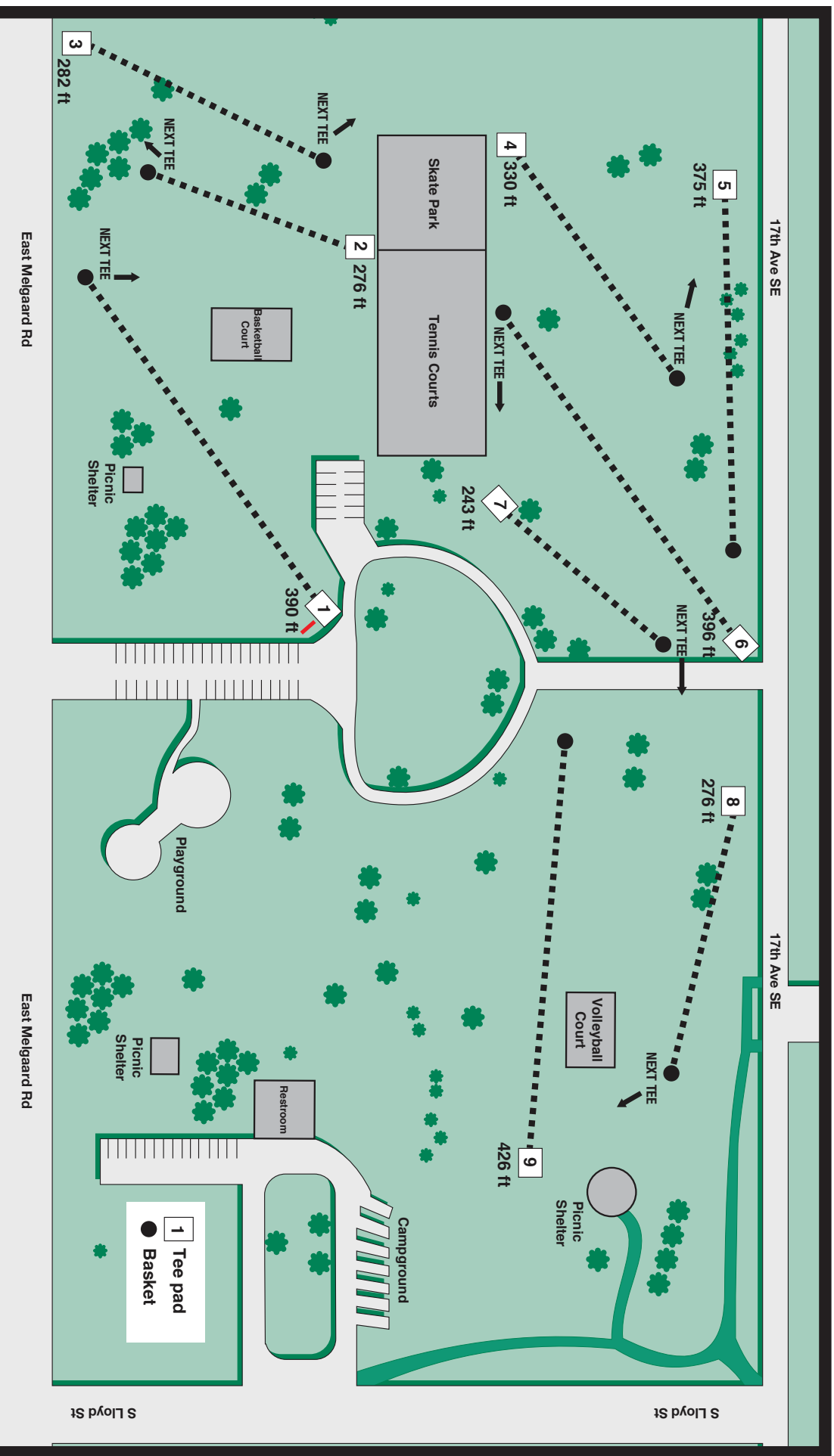
RULES OF PLAY

- A player must have a supporting point behind their disc and in line with the target when disc is released.
- Any throw within 30 feet of the basket requires that the player not move past his lie until the disc is at rest.
- Casual relief should be taken from an unsafe lie.

COURTESY AND ETIQUETTE

- Respect the course. Don't litter and do not alter trees or obstacles.
- Remain quiet and avoid distractions while others are throwing.
- Stand behind the player who is throwing until the throw is complete.
- Allow faster groups to play through when possible.
- Vandalism of equipment or landscaping is a serious offense that will be prosecuted.
