#### **NEW BUSINESS**

# PUBLIC HEARING - STORM SEWER PROJECT

Mayor Levsen opened the Public Hearing regarding the Aberdeen Storm Sewer Project on Kline Street. Ted Dickey, NECOG, discussed the need for the project to provide adequate storm water and sanitary sewer service to the City of Aberdeen. All alternatives were evaluated, including the cost of each, and were looked at by the City Engineer. Copies of the alternatives are listed in the facility plan.

This project will replace both the sanitary sewer and storm sewer on Kline Street between the railroad tracks and 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue South, and between 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue South and 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue South. This project will also include replacement of drinking water lines as with the construction of the sanitary and storm sewer the drinking water lines will be unsalvageable.

The City of Aberdeen is in the process of applying for funding from the South Dakota Department of Environment and Natural Resources for a Drinking Water Facility Funding. The amount of the SRF loan expected to be borrowed is up to \$1,500,000. The revenue source pledged for repayment is the Second Penny Sales Tax. The interest rate and term of the loan will be for up to 2.25% at a term no greater than 10 years. Since the City is using sales tax dollars to fund the project, it will not have any direct effect on sewer rates or storm sewer rates.

Campbell moved, Rux seconded the motion to approve Resolution No. 12-12-03R authorizing the loan:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND SUBMITTAL OF THE APPLICATION, AND DESIGNATING AN AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE TO CERTIFY AND SIGN PAYMENT REQUESTS

WHEREAS, the City of Aberdeen (the "City") has determined it is necessary to proceed with improvements to its Storm Sewer and Sanitary Sewer System, including but not limited to reconstruction of the storm sewer and sanitary sewer system on Kline Street (the"Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that financial assistance will be necessary to undertake the Project and an application for financial assistance to the South Dakota Board of Water and Natural Resources (the "Board") will be prepared; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to designate an authorized representative to execute and submit the application on behalf of the City and to certify and sign payment requests in the event financial assistance is awarded for the Project,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City as follows:

- 1. The City hereby approves the submission of an application for financial assistance in an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000 to the South Dakota Board of Water and Natural Resources for the Project.
- 2. The City of Aberdeen is hereby authorized to execute the application and submit it to the South Dakota Board of Water and Natural Resources, and to execute and deliver such other documents and perform all acts necessary to effectuate the application for financial assistance.
- 3. The City Manager is hereby designated as the authorized representative of the City to do all things on its behalf to certify and sign payment requests in the event financial assistance is awarded for the Project.

All present voting aye, motion carried.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held before the Planning Commission of the City of Aberdeen, South Dakota, on October 16, 2012, at 7:00 P.M. in the Community Room of the Brown County Courthouse, Aberdeen, South Dakota, pursuant to notice of such hearing for the purpose of considering the creation of Tax Incremental District No. 17 and its proposed boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City of Aberdeen did at its regular meeting on October 16, 2012, pass a resolution establishing the boundaries of such tax incremental district and did submit a recommendation to the City Council of the City of Aberdeen, South Dakota, recommending the creation of the said Tax Incremental District No. 17; and WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of City of Aberdeen, South Dakota, at its regular meeting on October 16, 2012 did pass a Resolution adopting the Project Plan for the proposed Tax Incremental District No.17 and did recommend to the City Council of the City of Aberdeen, South Dakota, that it approve and adopt the project plan as amended and;
