RESOLUTION NO. 14-01-04R

Campbell moved, Remily seconded to approve Resolution No. 14-01-04R as follows:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE USE OF VOTE CENTERS

WHEREAS, as per SDCL 12-14-17, that the Aberdeen City Council, Aberdeen, South Dakota, may authorize the use of vote centers in lieu of precinct polling places, providing that the election is conducted in conformance with all applicable election laws and rules, and

WHEREAS, the City of Aberdeen, South Dakota, in its entirety, will be considered one precinct with the use of vote centers.

WHEREAS, the use of vote centers will make voting more accessible for registered voters in the City of Aberdeen, South Dakota as they will be able to vote at any one of the vote centers, and

WHEREAS, the cost of purchasing electronic pollbooks, scanners, and other equipment required to facilitate vote centers is covered by Help America Vote Act Grant Funds, and

WHEREAS, the use of vote centers will decrease the expense of conducting the elections.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Aberdeen City Council declares all of the City of Aberdeen, South Dakota as one voting precinct and designated the following locations as vote centers:

1. Best Western Ramkota Hotel/Convention Center
2. Ramada Convention Center
3. Courthouse Community Room

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County A Office will be used as an absentee vote center to process absentee ballots on Election Day.
