

WAYS TO CONTRIBUTE

There are many ways in which you may make a gift to Storybook Land or Wylie Park and we will be pleased to discuss any of the following suggestions with you and your attorney, financial planner or personal representative. Outlined below are a number of options to consider.

Bequest - After making adequate provision in your will for your family, you may want to include Storybook Land or Wylie Park as a recipient of part of your estate.

Outright Gift - A gift today of cash or securities can give you some tax savings through a charitable contribution deduction and at the same time enhance a particular facility or program through the Park Gift Fund.

Life Insurance - It is relatively easy to transfer the ownership and beneficiary of a life insurance policy to the City of Aberdeen or Aberdeen Sertoma Club. A paid-up or partially paid policy can make a much larger gift than you may have imagined and provide for sizeable income tax deductions.

Real Property - A gift of real estate can release you from the management responsibilities in caring for property and eliminate payment of real estate taxes. Real estate provides the City of Aberdeen with a valuable asset which may benefit the entire community.
