

## **ABERDEEN AQUATICS CENTER RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **General Guidelines:**

- All swimmers shall be required to shower before entering the swimming area.
- All swimmers must wear appropriate swim wear. Cut-offs or other clothing not designed for swimming is not allowed.
- Persons having or reasonably suspected of having an area of exposed cuts, or recognizable communicable diseases, cough, cold, open sore, blisters, or bandaged wounds shall not be allowed to enter the pool water.
- All children ages 6 and under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at least 16 years of age.
- Running, boisterous or rough play, splashing, dunking, towel snapping or profanity shall not be permitted in the aquatic center area including the locker rooms.
- Foreign objects such as coins, water-wings, inflatable's, goggles with a nose piece, or snorkels are not allowed in the pool areas. Swim goggles may be worn during recreational swimming only, and are not permitted on the slides or diving boards.
- Lifeguard chairs and emergency equipment are for the use of lifeguards only.
- Diving is not permitted from the deck into shallow areas of the pools.
- Alcohol, tobacco or drugs are strictly prohibited from the Aberdeen Aquatic Center.
- Any person appearing to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs shall be asked to leave the aquatic center for their own safety as well as the safety of others.
