

ABERDEEN RECYCLING GUIDELINES



Put all recyclables LOOSE in your blue bin. **DO NOT bag recyclables other than office paper or newspaper, magazines, catalogs.** All recyclables must be clean and dry. Set your bin out by 7:00 AM on your trash collection day. Recyclables will not be picked up in alleys.



ALUMINUM & STEEL CANS



Aluminum and steel food and beverage containers. Empty and rinse all containers. **CANS MUST BE EMPTY.**

NO STEEL CAN LIDS, ALUMINUM FOIL OR PANS.

PLASTIC BOTTLES WITH SCREW ON LIDS

Bottles #1, #2, #3, #5 and #7. Clear and colored household plastic bottles with screw-on lids. Empty and rinse containers & remove paper labels.



DO NOT PUT THESE ITEMS IN YOUR BLUE

BIN: LIDS, CAPS OR SPRAYERS; BUTTER OR YOGURT CONTAINERS; ANTI-FREEZE, FERTILIZER, OIL, CHEMICAL CONTAINERS; WAXED CARTONS FROM ICE CREAM, JUICE OR ALMOND MILK, ETC.

PUT THESE MATERIALS IN SEPARATE PAPER GROCERY SACKS AND PLACE IN YOUR BIN ON TOP OF LOOSE RECYCLABLES:

OFFICE PAPER



Place your office paper in a separate grocery bag and place in your blue bin on top of your loose recyclables.

NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES, CATALOGS



Place your newsprint, newspapers, coupons, glossy inserts, flyers, catalogs, and phone books in a grocery bag, and place in your blue bin on top of your loose recyclables.

NO WET, SOILED OR GREASY PAPER, NO KLEENEX, PAPER TOWELS, NAPKINS OR PAPER PLATES.

CARDBOARD & PAPERBOARD BUNDLE SEPARATELY

Flatten empty corrugated cardboard and paperboard boxes in bundles no larger than 3 foot square and set under or in your recycling bin.



NO WET, GREASY OR SOILED CARBOARD
